# **Personal Contact Information In/On Your RC Airplane**

As a pleasant reminder, with us being an approved FAA-Recognized Identification Area (FRIAI), it is the AMA's policy for our members to affix your Name, Phone Number, AMA Number and your FAA number onto your airplane. If this label is placed inside the aircraft, it must be accessible by removing any panels, cowls or covers to get to the place where the label is visible without the use of tools.

#### **FRIA Effective Date Extended**

The FAA has approved about 700 FRIA Sites but still has 800-900 more to go. With this backlog, the FAA's September 23, 2023 enforcement date has been extended for 6 months to March 16, 2024. Fortunately, our field is one of the approved FRIA flying sites so no transponder is required.

#### **Club Officers & Directors Nominations**

The club By-Laws state we will vote on new nominated club Officers & Directors at our November meeting. Be thinking about who and what position you would like to nominate a club member for. I would suggest you ask that person if they are interested in becoming a club Officer or Director before nominating them.
