Mower is Serviced

On Saturday morning Sept 2nd about 6 members met at the shed to perform general maintenance on the Bobcat mower. Thank you for those that could help!! We got the oil changed, air & oil filters replaced, new blades put on and topped off the antifreeze. We discovered we will need some new fuel line to replace the fuel filter and some hydraulic fluid to replace the hydraulic filter. We will schedule this in a few weeks to complete the mower maintenance. We do have an extra set of belts, if and when we need to replace them. We have new folding arm rest on order. The LH is ready to ship but the RH has an extended delivery delay from the supplier. This is the second time from two different parts suppliers that I've tried to order the RH Armrest. The RH may have been discontinued, but I will continue to see if I can locate one.

WE ARE AN FRIA Approved Flying Site

On August 23, 2023, I received an affirming email from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) that our Robert Satow RC Flying Field for Club #3467 is an **APPROVED FRIA FLYING SITE!!**

This means since we are a member of a community-based organization (aka: Academy of Model Aeronautics) we can fly at our field and you DO NOT need a Remote Identification Signal to be transmitted from your RC plane. This includes anyone that is an AMA member in good standing, can fly at our field without the need for a transponder. It took many months of emails and documentation submissions and the help of the AMA, to get our FAA Recognized ID Area but it was all worth it. So, charge those batteries and let's put some planes in the air!!

Remember: Takeoffs are Optional, but Landing is Mandatory!!
