We are a friendly group of modelers that enjoy sharing the excitement of flying remote controlled model aircraft and would like to share the adventure with you. Our club members are involved in a broad spectrum of RC aircraft. This ranges from vintage models, bi-planes, sport models, trainers, pattern planes, IMAC (International Miniature Aerobatic Club) to ¼ scale airplanes and larger, all powered by glow engines, gas engines and electric motors.

**History:** Triad Aeromodelers Club started in the early 1990's. In 1995 the club was formalized into Triad Aeromodelers Inc., AMA Charter Club #3467 and purchased 18 acres of land north of Lexington, NC. In 2002 and 2006, adjacent land was purchased which now totals 31 acres.

**Flying Site:** We have an 80' x 700' grass runway that has been graded, crowned and reseeded in 2015. There is a covered area with plenty of picnic tables for watching RC aircraft while relaxing in the shade. We fly year round every Sunday and Tuesday if the weather is permitting (and sometimes even when it's not). As a member, you can fly anytime. We do restrict flying engine powered planes till noon on Sunday.



**Events:** Triad Aeromodelers sponsors an annual Swap Meet in mid-march at the Davidson County Fair Grounds. There are foods, drinks and raffle tickets for purchase and always fabulous door prizes. We bi-annually sponsor our local Boy Scouts clubs at our field to earn their Avionics Merit Badge. The day is packed with learning basic aeronautic principles and flying RC aircraft using buddy-box transmitter systems.



**Members and Memberships:** We are a friendly bunch of RC Flyers that enjoy meeting new people with the same interest. We are an Academy of Model Aeronautics chartered club mostly flying fixed wing remote control aircraft of all shapes and sizes. This ranges from small electric park flyers to quarter scale aircraft. We average 46 members per year with a 60 member limit. Helicopters and Quad-copters are allowed when no fixed wing aircraft are in the air.

**Club Meetings:** Our official club monthly meeting is held on the second Sunday of each month at 4:00 P March thru October at the field, then in November thru February, our monthly meeting is held the second Tuesday at one of the local restaurants. Meetings are open to guest as well so feel free to visit.

**Directions:** From Lexington, NC, take 29-70/Bus.85 north about a mile and turn right on Robert Everhart Rd. at the "Old Toy Chest Barn". Go to the end of the road and turn left on East Park Ave. Go about 100 yards and turn right on Lee Smith Rd. At the end of Lee Smith Rd. you will run out of pavement, continue down the gravel road, cross the railroad tracks (look both ways at the tracks!!), thru the gates. The field will be about another ¼ mile down the gravel road which runs into our parking lot..
